## Questions to ask Your doctor?

- 1. Would you please write down the exact type of lung cancer I have?
- 2. Will you please speak or write in the simplest terms (1st Grader terms)
- 3. May I have a copy of my pathology report?
- 4. Has my cancer spread beyond the place where it started?
- 5. What is the stage of my cancer? What does that mean in my case?
- 6. How aggressive is the cancer spreading?
- 7. Are there other tests that need to be done before we can decide on treatment?
- 8. Are there other doctors I need to see?
- 9. How much experience do you have treating this type of cancer?
- 10. What treatment choices do I have?
- 11. What do you suggest and why?
- 12. What is the goal of this treatment?
- 13. How will my day to day activities be affected?
- 14. How long will treatment last? What will it involve? Where will it be done?
- 15. How quickly do we need to decide on treatment?
- 16. What are the chances my cancer can be cured with these options?
- 17. What risks or side effects are there to the treatment you suggest? How long are they likely to last?
- 18. What type of follow-up will I need after treatment?
- 19. Will I need any type of physical therapy?
- 20. What are the chances of the cancer coming back after treatment? What would we do if that happens?
- 21. What should I do to get ready for treatment?
- 22. Do you have a recommended diet for me? If the doctor doesn't offer a nutritional plan, request a Nutritionist.
- 23. What is the best and most effective way to communicate with you regarding the status of my health?
